

Catch-up Premium

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard (scaled score of 99 or below) in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2.

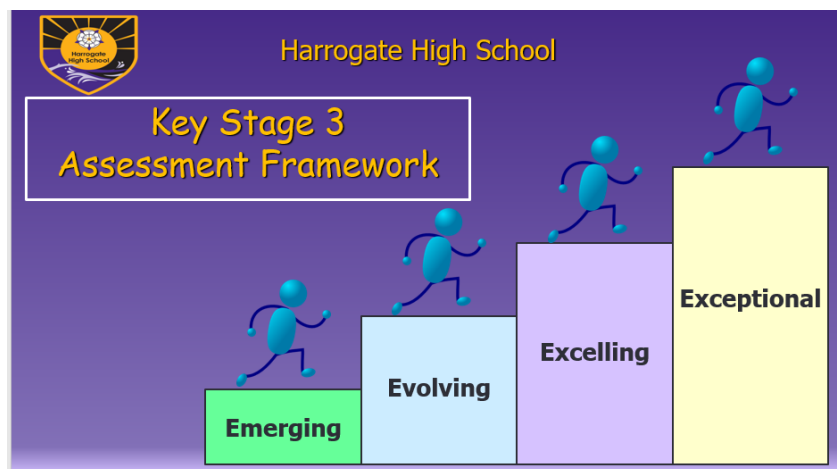
In 2018/19 we received £ 22188.00. Our allocation for 19/20 has not been confirmed yet.

We used this funding in 18/19 to provide year 7 students with the following additional support for English and Maths:

- Lexia – phonics intervention
- Reading intervention programme
- Mymaths intervention
- Additional English and Maths lessons per week
- Accelerated Reader programme
