RE: STUDENT EQUIPMENT

As you will be aware, when school reopened on Wednesday 9 September, all students were issued with a learning pack. The plastic zip lock pack contained a mini whiteboard, whiteboard pen, pen, pencil, ruler, glue stick, small bottle of sanitiser and face mask. We supported students in this way to reduce the risk of contamination as all learning packs were to remain in school and used only by that individual.

We have been extremely proud of our students and how they have adapted to the new COVID safety measures. Whilst we have supported students in adjusting to using their new packs and replacing any missing items, we need to inform you that, with effect from **Monday 2nd November**, unless your child is eligible for FSM, a payment item will be generated on ParentPay for missing items which need to be purchased during the school day. As I am sure you can appreciate, we cannot sustain replacing this type of equipment for all students as this is a cost usually met by families.

We hope you appreciate and understand the reason for this update but trust we can rely on your continued support.
